Our project begins to collect the fruits of a sustained job. Here are the last national teams results:

Croatia. Dissemination of information about the PSI WELL Project at the level of activities organized within a master's program, but also in an education center which organized a meeting with 300 specialists in the field of special education. Also, other dissemination events organized by the Croatian team took place at day centers and schools where it was planned to present the project both to specialists and teachers and to the children's parents.

Lithuania. The Lithuanian team presented the web page and Facebook page of the project as a way to disseminate the project. Also, in March 2018, during the participation in an international congress, two sections of communications and a poster section of elements from the PSI WELL project were presented.

Portugal. Our partners announced a very important event for the dissemination of PSIWELL Projects results at the International Emotional Intelligent Congress which will be held in 21-23 February 2019 period in Bragança, Portugal. Another dissemination activity carried out by the Portuguese team

was a presentation of the PSI WELL project in the European Parliament. Other dissemination activities communicated by the Portuguese team are several national and international conferences where the PSI WELL project was presented. In addition, in November 2018, a meeting will be held with social inclusion specialists in African countries, such as Mozambique and Angola, countries where there is a good functioning of social inclusion policies.

Romania. Two international conferences and several meetings with teachers who have much more contact with the families of children with special needs. In June 2018, The PSI_WELL Projected had a special section inside the The XIXth Congress of the AMSE-AMCE-WAER with title: Promoting social inclusion and wellbeing for families of children with special needs - an Erasmus+ initiative. AMSE (The World Association for Educational Research) is promotes scientific research in the field of education and the teaching of the sciences of education at university level and internationally.

Spain. The first dissemination activity that the Spanish team exemplifies is the process of publishing a scientific article on the results of the PSI WELL project. The article is in the evaluation of a prestigious scientific journal in Spain. On the other hand, the Spanish team collaborates with a very large number of schools (about 100) that will connect them with families with children with special needs to participate in parent training.
